EDUCATION DEPARTMENT RECEIVES TERM TWO TUITION FEE GRANTS

Secretary for Education, Dr. Uke Kombra has thanked the National Government for living up to its commitment by providing the full funding of K158 million for Term 2 despite the difficult economic times.

The funds will be paid into school accounts before the end of Term 1.

"On behalf of the Minister for Education Hon. Jimmy Uguro, MP and schools under the National Education System, I thank the National Government for its full commitment and support to the Ministry of Education," Dr. Kombra said.

Dr. Kombra also advised school administrators to complete and have School Learning Improvement Plans (SLIP) to spend these monies on tangible resources including infrastructure development and support teaching and learning in their schools.

He called on the school administrations to acquit the monies spent and provide quarterly reports to the Department, through the Provincial Education Offices in order to receive tuition fee grants. "Parents and community have a right to ask School Boards to account and acquit these public funds every time and anytime".
